Kentucky Derby Fundraiser

Horse races, hat contest, mint juleps, and good food were all part of the Friends of the Library first Kentucky Derby Party. Approximately 100 people attended the fun event at the Safari Golf Course in Powell on May 4 and \$5,000 was raised for the Delaware County District Library for the Maker Annex at Willis Educational Center in Delaware, Ohio.

"The Maker Annex is a great asset to the Delaware County community," said Karen Cowan, FOL President, "and we wanted to help it get off to a great start, so we decided to have a fundraiser to help."

The ambiance of the Kentucky Derby was recreated as the party-goers began the evening watching a simulcast of the Kentucky Derby. The Derby was quickly followed by a hat contest where over 40 party goers showed off their best Kentucky Derby hats. Zach Price, Triad Architects, was the "Best hat" winner with his Kentucky Derby hat spotlighting a trophy, race horse and jockey. The FOL Derby began after the hat contest with the first of 2 heats to determine the horses running in the FOL Derby.

After a "best of show" vote for the favorite horse, the FOL Derby was run with Bobsky, sponsored by George Needham and Joyce Leahy, winning the final race.

According to Kellen Freeman, who is in charge of the Maker Annex, "the Maker Annex will be targeted as a "technology learning space" for middle school students from Delaware County." Money from the Derby will go towards buying supplies for the Maker Annex. *(more pics on Page 2)*
